





3. Did you feel you had access to a computer in high school when you needed one?







4. Could you explain the district's technology acceptable use policies (Internet access, cell phone use) that affect students?






12. Have you been taught the law regarding copying of text, graphics, sound, and software from electronic sources (Internet, online encyclopedias, etc.)?


